COUNCIL MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE: BONNIE BUTTERBAUGH, SALLY ACTON, ALAN FISHER, CHARLOTTE MEYER, CHUCK WOLCOTT, MIKE DRODOFSKY ABSENTEES WERE: JOHN LEIST, RUBY WOLCOTT, JONETTE HILL

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDENT, ALAN FISHER, WITH ALAN PRESENTING DEVOTIONS.

ONCE AGAIN THIS YEAR, A CHRISTMAS TREE WILL BE IN THE LOBBY WITH NAMES OF CHILDREN WHO WILL NEED SEVERAL GIFTS FOR CHRISTMAS. A MOTION WAS MADE BY CHARLOTTE MEYER TO CAP THE CONTRIBUTIONS TO \$150 FOR EACH CONTRIBUTOR TO THIS PROGRAM.
