### THE INSIDE STORY BY SALLY ACTON

This week's sending song, "Amazing Grace", was written by John Newton. Some things you may not know about his famous hymn. His title for it wasn't "Amazing Grace" originally but "Faith's Review and Expectation". It is based on 1 Chronicles 17:16-17. Here is a nearly forgotten verse that Newton added near the end,

The earth shall soon dissolve like snow, The Sun forbear to shine; But God, who called me here below, Shall be forever mine.
